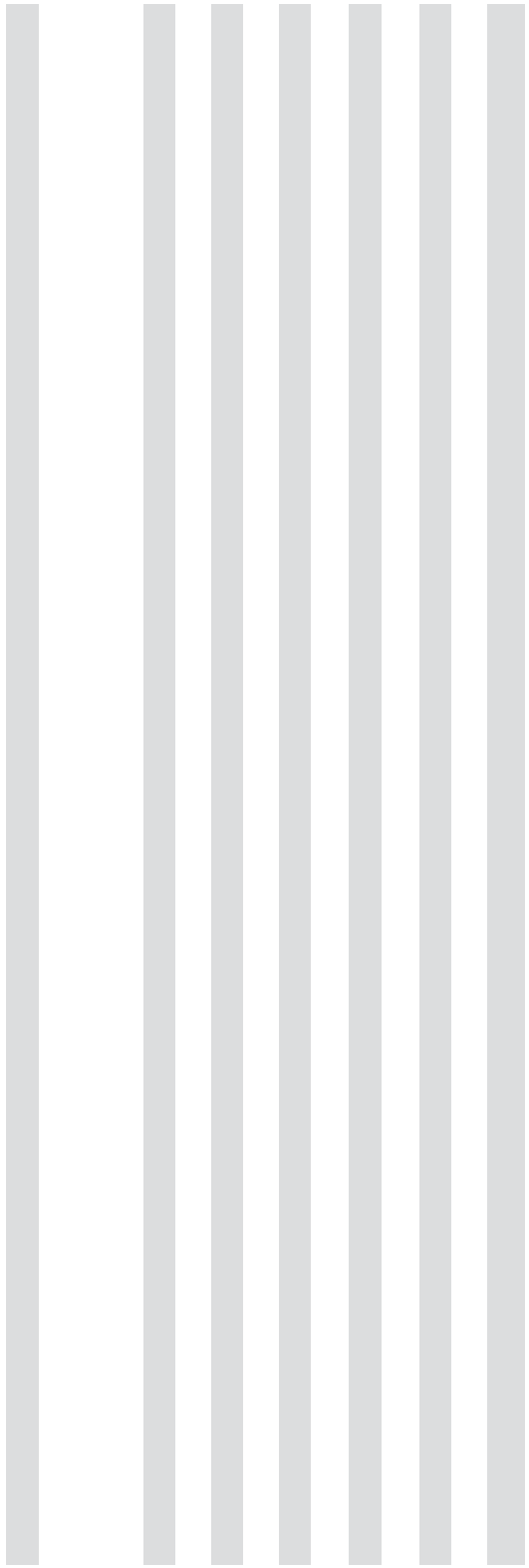

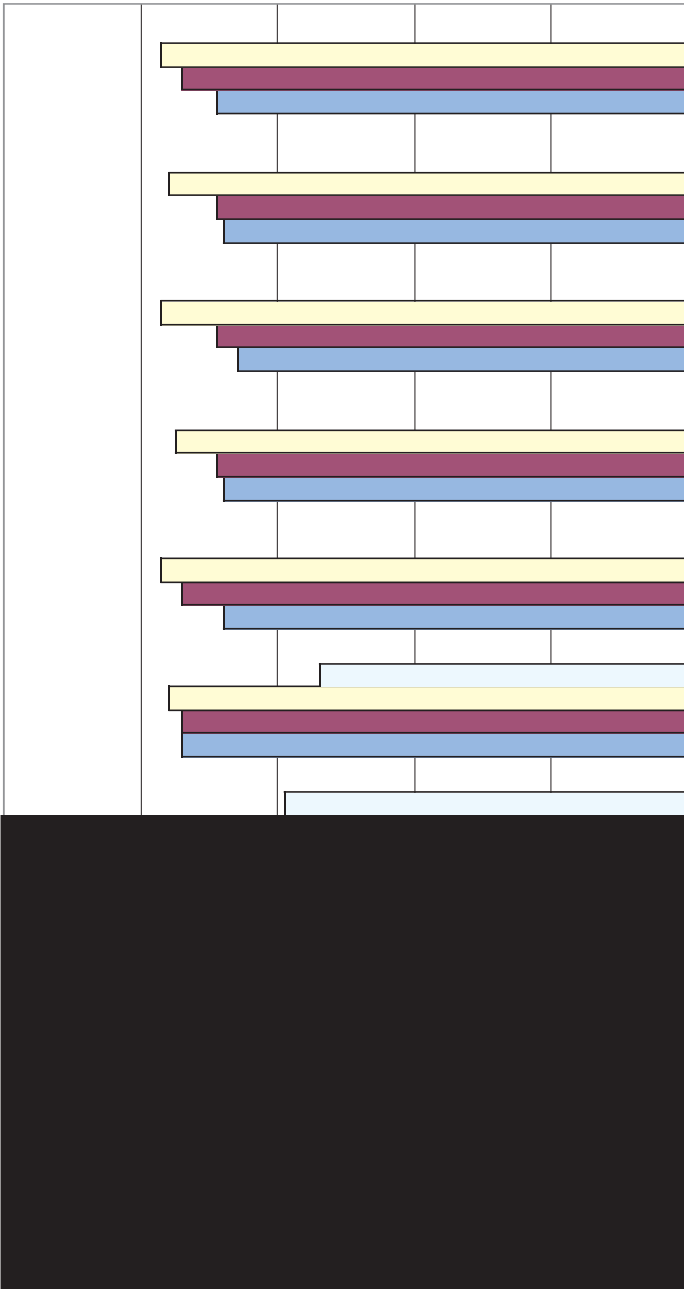
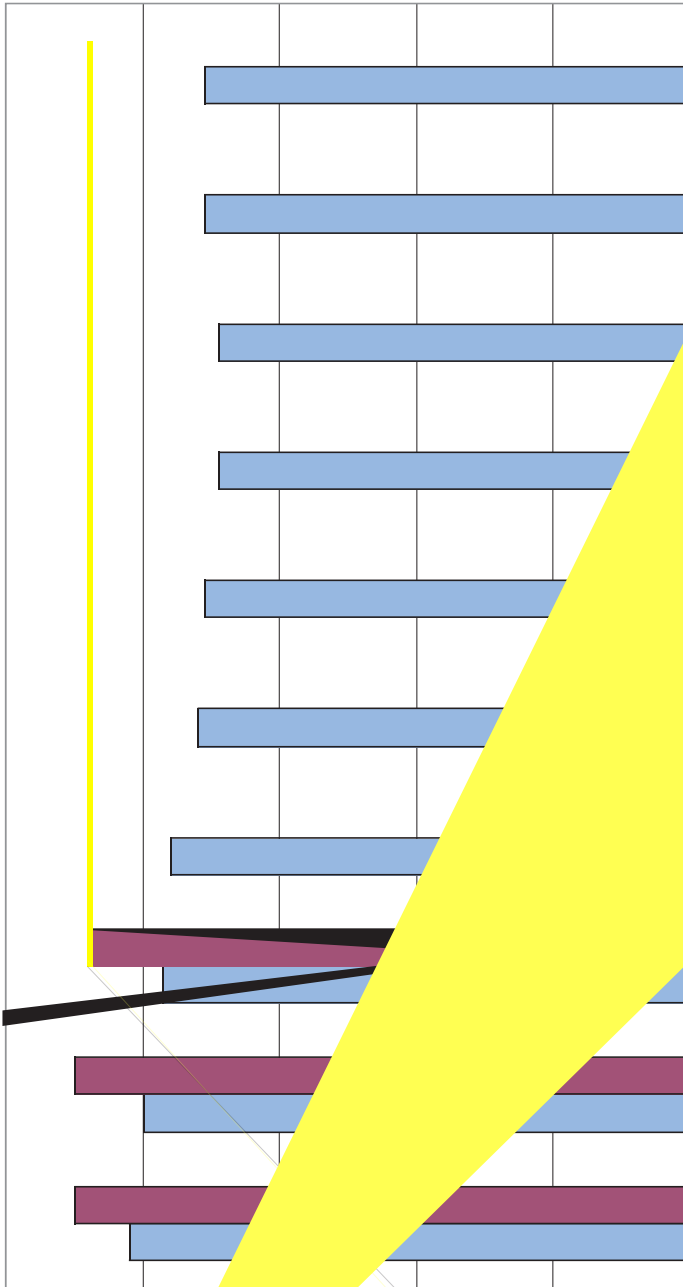


Figure 3. NCELEX-RN® Annual Pass Rates, April 1994 - December 2003

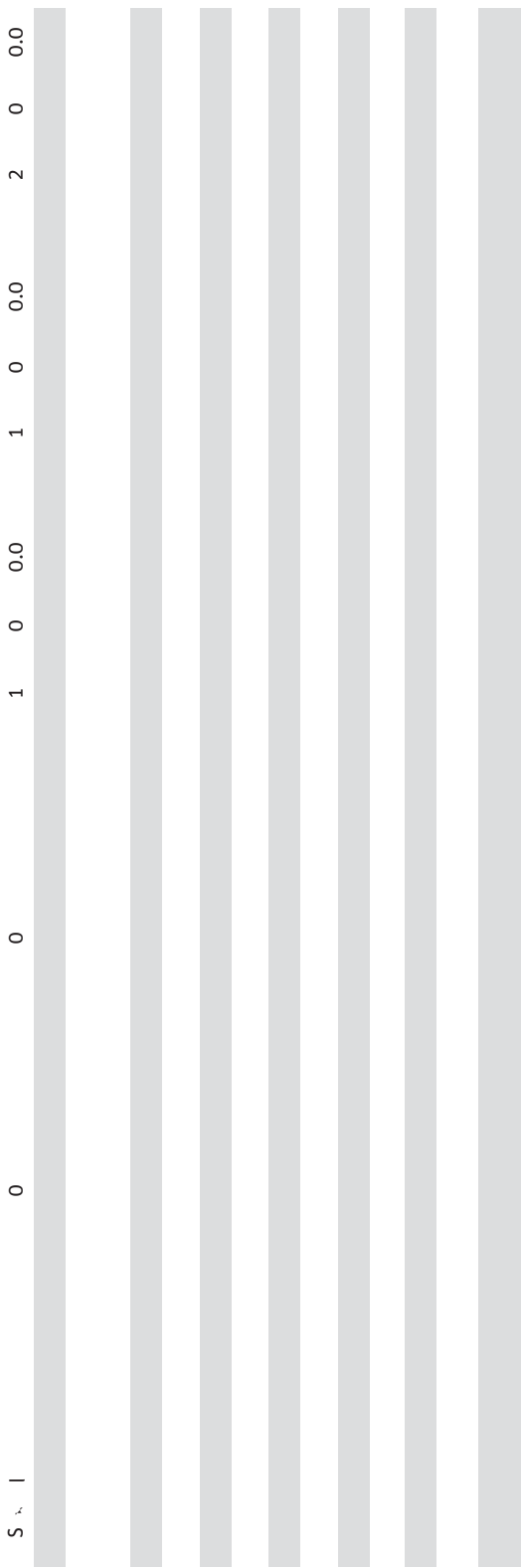
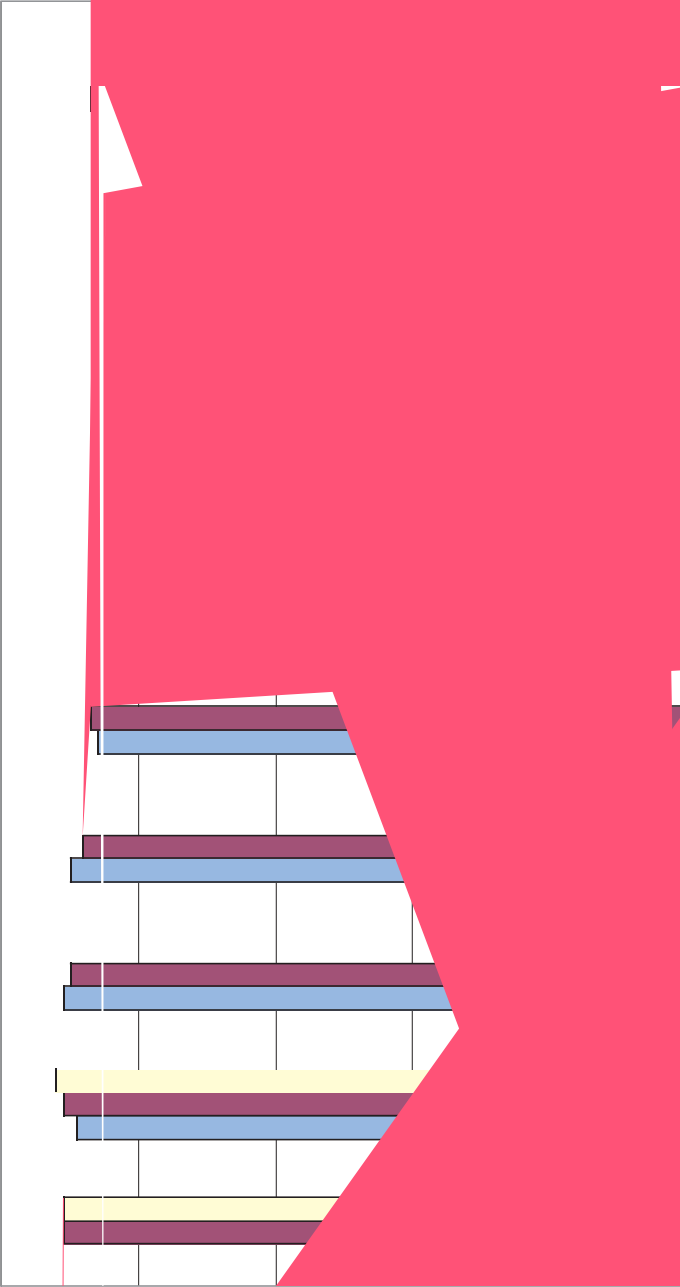


Figure 7. NCLEX-PN® Pass Rates for First-Time, U.S.-Educated Candidates

***A 1999 P Pass Rate = 51% (CAT) and 1999 A Pass Rate = 47% (CAT)

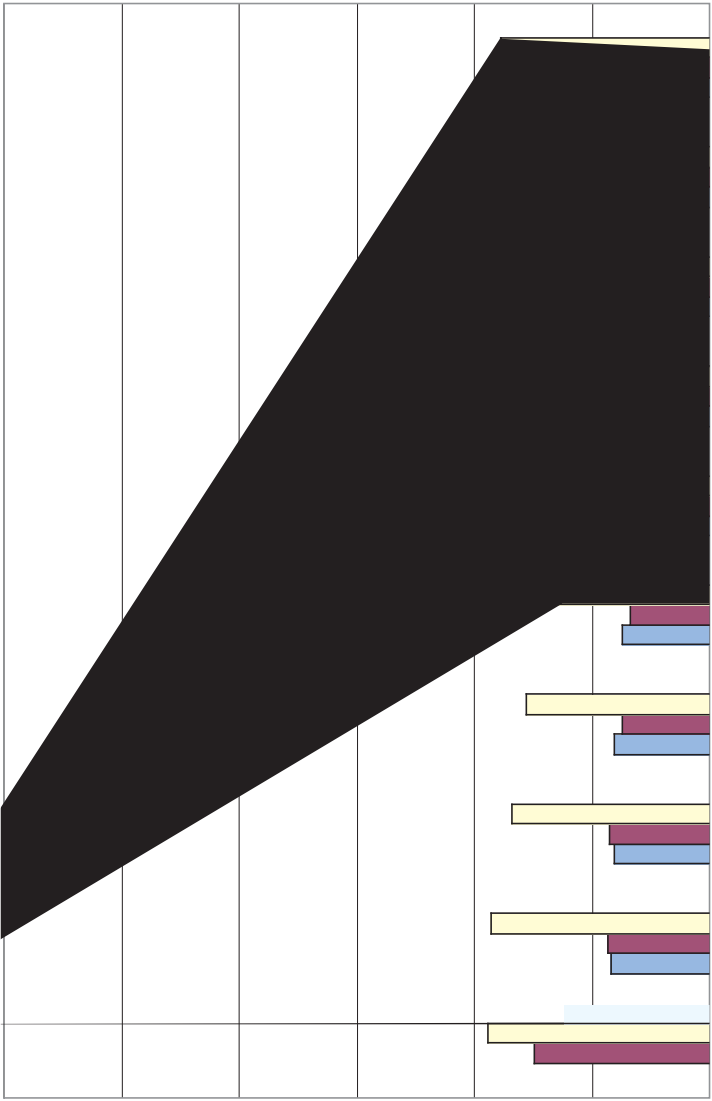
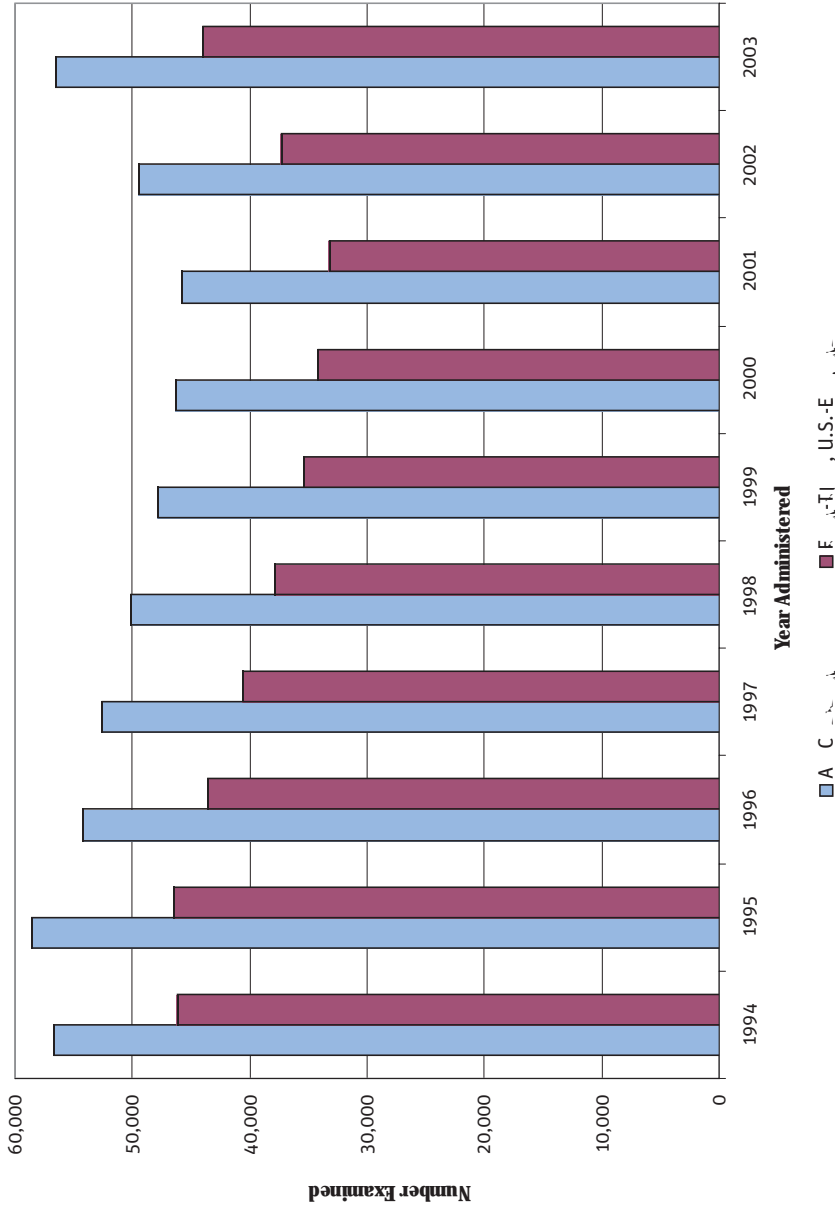


Figure 12. NCLEX-PN® Annual Volume, April 1994 - December 2003





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
